## EUROPEAN CHERRY WOOD



The beautiful lines of Cherry wood shafts and the occasional tiny knots, distinguish from any other hardwood. It has a silky appearance.

The cherry wood is a very popular and ornamental species and is searched since XVII century. Today, it's used in delicate work to interior structures, furniture, decorative items and musical instruments.

**Type:** hardwoods of the temperate zone

**Other names:** Ceasus AVIUM, fruit cherry, Kirsche, merisier, kers

**Related species:** Pado (P. Padus)

**Origin:** Europe and parts of Asia and North Africa

**Color:** Pale or reddish brown

**Texture:** thin and uniform

**Wood grain:** In large part it is straight, but with some fine lines of wood of autumn

**Hardness:** Moderated

**Weight:** Medium (610 kg/m<sup>3</sup>)

**Application:** Manufacture of furniture, interior woodwork, decoration and sheet of wood.
